# CAMP LOGISTICS

## RESPONSIBLE CARE

- CDC recommendations and covid19.ca.gov guidance for daycamps will be met.
- Small Groups: 12 Campers per every 2 counselors will occupy designated spaces during each camp activity circuit (drama, dance, art and music).
- Employees will be provided with all required protective equipment (i.e. face coverings and gloves). Face coverings (mask covering nose and mouth) are required when employees are in the vicinity of others. Face coverings will not be shared.
- Temperatures will be taken daily for both camp employees and campers to ensure no fever is present. Individuals with temperatures at or below 100.3 F may enter camp. Any individual with a temperature of 100.4 F or greater is considered to have a fever and will not be permitted at camp. All results will be recorded via the SoCo COVID-19 Employee Check – Mobile App
- Anti-bacterial cleaning will be conducted at all camp stations and designated snack/lunch area throughout the day. The entire camp location will be cleaned by our own professionals after each day of camp.
- Hand-washing will be enforced throughout the day with various hand sanitizer stations offered at camp.
- Campers will use unshared, personal materials for their art projects
- Campers will bring their own lunches and not share food or drink with fellow campers.
